### **RANGE SAFETY TOPICS OF THE MONTH**

Below are just a few things to think about before one chambers that first round of the day.

- Make sure your firearm is in good mechanical condition before firing it. Periodically have your firearm checked for signs of erosion, cracking, or wear by the factory, or a qualified certified gunsmith.
- Never try to fire a gun, which may have a plugged or partially obstructed barrel. Could ruin ones day!
- Insure that any modifications made to a firearm are made by a qualified individual, and that those modifications don't interfere with your firearm's safety features.
