## **PRESIDENTS MESSAGE.**

Let me start by wishing all members a healthy and prosperous NEW YEAR.

I must also thank everyone who attended the Chuck Faustman celebration of life last November 24<sup>th</sup> he was very active in the club and will be greatly missed by all.

The board has come back with recommended changes to the by laws, which are enclosed with this newsletter and will be posted on the web site <http://www.the-lsc.org>. Please take the time to read, the board put a lot of work and extra personal time to make these recommend changes. We are recommending increasing both the yearly dues and trailer rental due to increased operating cost. From 3/01/06 to 2/28/07 the club had a deficit of (-\$3367.85) and from 3/1/07 to 9/30/07 the deficit is (-\$1446.70). There are three major factors for this deficit: Payment on our new diesel tractor, our other one was gas, a larger diesel generator and the doubling of diesel fuel in the past 18 months. The board strongly recommends passage of the changes to bring the club back into positive cash flow.

The board has voted to have our first membership drive and it was agreed upon that if a member in good standing sponsors a known friend or family the sponsors annual dues will be waived for one year. This takes affect January 2008 and goes until June 2008.

Ballots for the next board are also enclosed with this newsletter, please vote it is your club.

The Que ball for the pool table was misplaced after the service in November, it is a special ball that must be used so the club can make money with it. Please check and see if it was picked up during the clean up and taken home by accident.

Our care taker is in need of a replacement washer & dryer, if anyone knows of one available please contact the board. Gotta keep the care taker in clean clothes.

We are asking all club members that have trailers or RV's parked at the camp to ensure that the registration is current; this is a requirement per the by-laws. I will be sending out letters to club members affected, **SECOND NOTICE**. Once the board has established a regular storage area we will require that if the trailers are not used that they be placed in storage. This issue is being address by the rules committee they will have proposed changes to by the first of next year. ## RANGE SAFETY TOPICS OF THE MONTH

Below are just a few things to think about before one chambers that first round of the day.

- Receive competent instruction from a qualified person before beginning to shoot. If questions arise later, after you've been shooting for a period of time, get answers to those questions from a competent authority.
