Other trap business, the manual throwers need to be replaced. Cat moved and Phillip 2nd that Rich purchase replacements: Passed.

Rifle/Pistol Report: Schedule and Breakfast as before, etc. Phillip is in process of fixing metal targets. Rich brought up posting of safety rules on the range. He likes the rules that Lemon Grove has. Ted will post for web/email and Rich will take on range project.

Ted wants to know how many turkeys we're going to cook. There were 8 last year and it was agreed to do only 4 this year. Figure in enough beef so we'll have left over. Bought 168 lbs. last year, if we can figure out, maybe buy more this year. Joanne has tickets. Emily is making a list for meat preparation, etc. On BBQ weekend, Jeff wants to post schedule of events so people will know what to expect. Ted wanted to know who's going to do what. Emily will do the scavenger hunt and Jeff the horseshoes. More suggestions for activities could be bingo and movies, and any other ideas we might have.

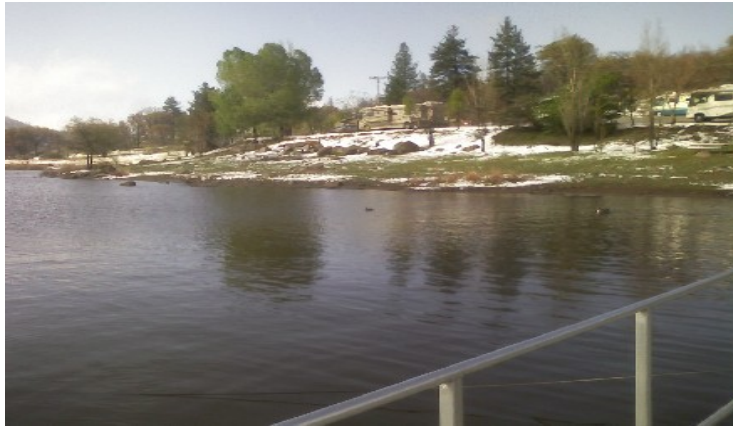
