RANGE SAFETY RULES

KEEP FIREARMS UNLOADED UNTIL ON FIRING LINE AND IT'S YOUR TURN TO SHOOT.
ACTIONS SHALL REMAIN OPEN UNTIL YOUR TURN TO SHOOT.

TREAT ALL FIREARMS AS THOUGH THEY'RE LOADED – POINTING IN A SAFE DIRECTION.

KNOW YOUR TARGET AND WHAT LIES BEYOND YOUR TARGET.

IN CASE OF A MISFIRE, KEEP MUZZLE POINTED DOWN RANGE
AND CALL FOR A RANGE SAFETY OFFICER.

JUNIORS (UNDER 18 YEARS OLD) ARE TO BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT.

REMOVE DEBRIS AND EMPTY CASES FROM THE SHOOTING AREA AFTER YOU ARE FINISHED
AND PLACE IN APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS.

NO FRANGIBLE TARGETS ARE ALLOWED EXCEPT CLAY TARGETS.

EYE AND HEARING PROTECTION IS REQUIRED ON THE FIRING LINE.

BE SURE YOU ARE USING THE CORRECT AMMUNITION.

FIREARMS SHALL BE UNLOADED AND PLACED IN RACKS PROVIDED WHEN NOT IN USE.
