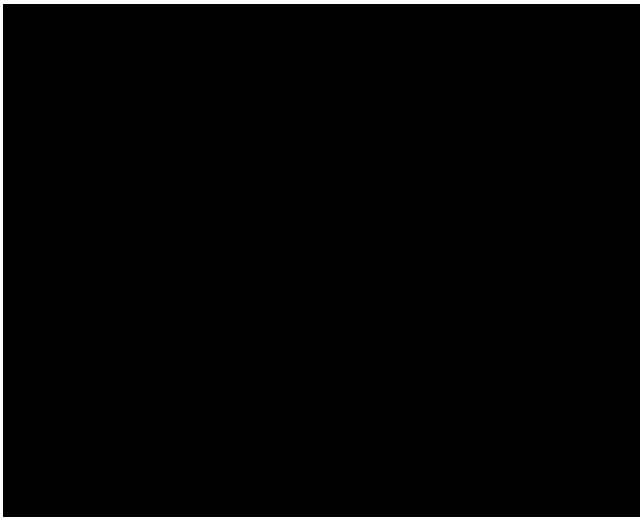
- Price of fuel has gone up.
